**Explanatory Note**

OpGen, Inc. (the “Registrant”) is filing this Registration Statement on Form S-8 (the “Registration Statement”) to register an additional 345,828 shares of its common stock, par value \$0.01 per share (“Common Stock”), for issuance under the OpGen, Inc. 2015 Equity Incentive Plan, as amended and restated (the “Plan”). Registrant effected a one (1) for twenty-five (25) reverse stock split of its common stock on January 17, 2018, and all share numbers in this Registration Statement reflect the impact of the reverse stock split. Pursuant to General Instruction E to Form S-8, the contents of Registrant’s prior Registration Statement on Form S-8 (File No. 333-205864) are incorporated herein by reference except to the extent supplemented, amended or superseded by the information set forth herein. Only those items of Form S-8 containing new information not contained in the earlier registration statement are presented herein.
